



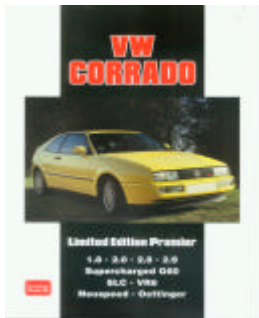

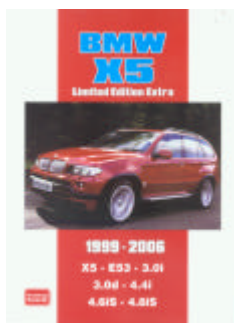

Its story is traced thru model introductions, road, comparison and long term tests plus performance data. Also included is an informative 'Used car profile'.
