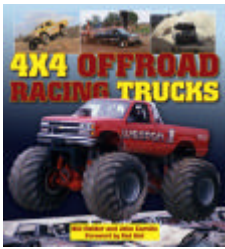
## NEW YORK FIFTH AVENUE COACH COMPANY 1885-1960

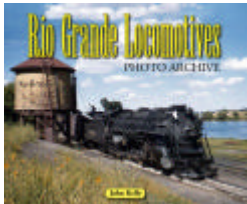

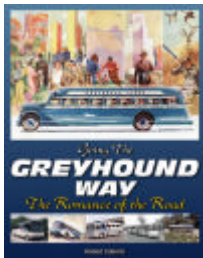

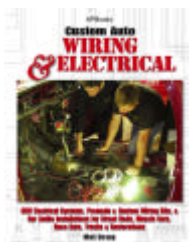
